#### **IMPACTS**

### From Sales of Oysters

 Income from USD80 increases to USD1000 per month

#### From Tourism Package

- Charging USD2 per pax for visit to oyster platform
- Charging USD10 per pax for visit to platform inclusive of light meals
- USD5 for 3 pieces of oysters

#### Opportunities for womenfolks

 Generating a minimum of USD80 per month for cooking

#### Opportunities for school children

- Avoid "lounging around" during school holiday or after school
- Cleaning trays, obtaining daily allowances about USD5 per day
